One PGA professional and three amateurs per team. One gross and one net best ball with full handicap, plus low professional purse. All amateurs must have an established handicap verified by a PGA professional (USGA GHIN handicap). All handicaps will be verified.

Limited to <u>first 50 teams</u>. \*A team may be comprised of four amateurs provided one amateur plays scratch and will not receive amateur prizes.

<u>August 12:</u> One half of the field will play The Honors Course, one half will play Council Fire. Lunch will be served at each Course.
