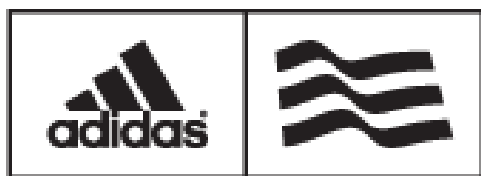

FORMAT

One PGA professional and three amateurs per team. One gross and one net best ball with full handicap, plus low professional purse. All amateurs must have an established handicap verified by a PGA professional (USGA GHIN handicap). All handicaps will be verified.

Limited to first 50 teams. *A team may be comprised of four amateurs provided one amateur plays scratch and will not receive amateur prizes.

August 12: One half of the field will play The Honors Course, one half will play Council Fire. Lunch will be served at each Course.

August 13: Teams will change courses, each playing the course they have not yet played. Lunch & awards will follow play at each course.

Entry Fee

Entry is \$2,000 per Team
(\$615 per amateur, \$155 professional) payable to the Tennessee Golf Foundation. Approx. 45% of your entry fee is tax deductible. In order to receive tax deductibility each player should make their entry payable to TGF.

Benefits

Entry fee includes lunch at each course on Monday & Tuesday, one round at The Honors and one round at Council Fire, Cookout at The Honors, range balls, cart, drinks on the course, favors and prizes. All groups at The Honors will use a forecaddie & cart.
